DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Yale Africa Conference (SOCA Sponsoring)
 - Four execs have shown interest (even though soca can't afford it) so we're seeking support from other SFU departments for funding. If the money can't be raised through sponsorships, we are asking for soca to provide \$2000 for expenses such as flight and conference tickets as well as accommodations
- BHM (Fundraising)
 - Planning 3 events, the anniversary will be the final. We plan to use it to also start a fundraiser for a black student support fund for those in need. We'll be selling soca merch to that end. All funds from sales go to the fund. The merch will be cute/cool. The price is undetermined. Exec hoodies are also being printed. But are reserved for previous years' execs. However, we plan to make new hoodies for the new team before the end of the next fiscal year

MOTIONS

1. Black History Month 2024

Whereas SOCA is organizing a series of events for the 2024 Black History Month (BHM) celebration,

Whereas these events will be centered around building a stronger black community and taking up space constantly

Be it resolved that SOCA approves a total amount of \$9,250 from the SOCA Black Student Support Fund for all the BHM related activities - Opening Ceremony, Panel Discussion, Games Night, Cultural Night aka 30th Anniversary etc..

Be it further resolved that this amount be taken out of line item; 34, 35, 36, 37 38. Account 795/45

2. Collaboration with Sweet x Sawa and UBC AAI

Whereas SOCA members have discussed the collaboration request from Sweet x Sawa in relation to a Back to School event they are organizing together with UBC AAI.

3. Men's talk Social

4. Motion for Support to International Student in Need of Tuition Support

Whereas there's a request for financial support to help clear up the tuition debt of one of SOCA's member who is an international student;

Whereas this student has a case manager at SFU who has vetted their situation and had multiple conversations to validate their need for support;

Whereas a good portion of their debt has been cleared up, but there's a leftover of \$500 which is preventing them from enrolling in Spring classes;

Whereas prior conversations has been had that this support is only for the interim and not constant financial support as SOCA has limited resources

Be it resolve that SOCA helps clear up this student debt of \$500 in order for them to enroll in Spring class;

Be it further resolved that this amount be taken out of our core account

5. Motion to set up Go-Fund Me and Donate Support to International Student in **Need of Tuition Support.** (Postponed)

Whereas a member of SOCA reached out and asked for financial support with their tuition in order to enroll in future classes;

Whereas we had multiple conversations on their situation and they would appreciate this support and asks to remain anonymous;

Whereas SOCA will be setting up a Go-Fund-Me page with approval of members that encompasses their full story to support the Black student at SFU who needs financial support in paying off their tuition of \$8,000 with SFU to continue their education and fulfill their study permit requirements;

Whereas there's a Bursary line item in the SOCA BSSC levy fund budgeted has not been used and has \$2000 in it;

Whereas the "SFU Black Student Support Campaigns" line item has a total of \$600.00 Remaining;

Be it resolved that SOCA approves the amount of \$2000 to donate towards the Go-Fund Me to contribute the amount of \$8,000 for this cause with line item "48" SFU BSC Black Student Bursary Contribution as a donation via a transfer to that SFU Finance through the SFSS office or via donation to GoFundMe to a student in distress who has been liaising with the SFSS Students Advocate office

6. Yale Africa Innovation Funding Support

Whereas SOCA was extended an invite to the Yale Africa Innovation Symposium 2024, which is scheduled to take place at the Yale University Campus, New Haven;



Whereas four SOCA executives have shown interest in attending this event as an opportunity to connect with other black students and communities in North America and also equip themselves with skills gotten from the various innovation labs hosted by Yale Africa;

Whereas the total expenses of this trip is estimated around \$5000, which includes flights, accommodation and conference tickets:

Whereas SOCA executives are currently reaching out to other departments of SFU for sponsorship opportunities to help alleviate the proposed costs;

Be it resolved that in the event the sponsorships gotten from other departments is not sufficient, SOCA can support with an amount of up to \$2000 to cover any leftover expense;

Be it further resolved that this amount be taken out of the following accounts; \$500 from the core account, \$1000 from the trust account, Account 5091/Z and \$500 from line item "52", SOCA BSSC Annual Conference / Speaker Series

7. Printing of the SOCA Executive Hoodies

Whereas the SOCA executive hoodie had a project that started at the start of last fiscal year with an approved design by executives for these hoodies.

Whereas the purchase of hoodies has been done but yet to be printed on, due to not finding a black business that can do the printing

Whereas these hoodies were initially agreed upon to be printed by a black-owned business but that is no longer feasible at the moment and will be printed by Document Solutions.

Whereas these hoodies will be given to the 2022/23 executive team, as the executive team who began the project and if there's enough room, will be made accessible to the executive team 2023/24.

Be it resolved that SOCA approves the amount of \$403.20 for the printing of these hoodies



Be it further resolved that this amount be taken out of line item 71, "Soca Swag", Acct 815/45
